Mrs. C. H. Harrell, owner and proprietor of a swimming pool in the City appeared before the City Commission and requested that a special rate, (one lower than the one now applicable,) on water to be used at the swimming pool be granted her. After discussing the matter, it was unanimously decided that inasmuch as the operation of said swimming pool was purely a commercial proposition a reduction in the water rate now being charged could not be reduced, therefore the application was refused.
