

Lufkin Texas September 18th 1895

Council Met pursuant to adjournment Mayor Mantooth in the chair J Kerr, W H Bonner, R B Shearer and S Abram Alderman Present and the following business was Transacted

Art 31 Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Lufkin that for the purpose of more fully carrying out the provisions of Article 25 of the ordinances of the City of Lufkin. When it may be ^{thought} necessary for the safety of the Town for any three of the ~~the~~ ^{City} Aldermen to examine any and all wooden buildings within the fire limits of the City of Lufkin to determine whether or not the same may be repaired or removed according to the conditions prescribed in said article 25. provided the said Councilmen shall give the owner or agent of any building within said limits one days notice of their intentions to examine said building. provided said Aldermen making the said examination shall make their report to the city Council in writing which report shall state the actual condition of any such building by them examined stating the original value of the same the present value thereof and the condition

of same with respect to fire provided that when said report shall show that said building has deteriorated in value fifty per cent of its original cost. the same shall be removed by the Marshal under the provisions of said article 25-

Art 31 Be it ordained by the city council of the City of Lufkin

Art 32 that if any person shall discharge any fire crackers roman candles or any other fire works or fire toys within the fire limits of the City of Lufkin. or within the Rail Road reservation opposite the Depot in the City of Lufkin shall be fined in any sum not less than five ~~Dollars~~ nor more than twenty five Dollars

Art 32 Be it ordained by the city council of the City of Lufkin

Art 33 that any person who shall be the owner of any building or other structure within this incorporate limits of the said Town who shall fail or refuse to ^{remove} or repair any such building in accordance with any ordinance passed by the city council of the City of Lufkin shall be fined in any sum not less than ten Dollars nor more than fifty Dollars provided that each such person shall have twenty days

Notice in which to repair or remove
Such building or structure

Art. 21 Be it ordained by the city council
of the city of Lufkin
that any Building that has or
May become in Such condition
as to be Dangerous for promoting
fire shall be Declared a nuisance
and require the same to be
repaired or removed by the owner
or agent of Such building

Art. 22 Be it Ordained by the city council
of the city of Lufkin
that R B Shearer Serron Abram
and W H Bonner are hereby appoi-
-nted a Committie to examine all
Houses and Structures within the
limits of the Corporation of the
City of Lufkin for the purpose
of determining their condition
for promoting fires and to report
their condition to the city council
in writing

to the Honorable City
it is ordered by the city council of
the city of Lufkin that C Mantooth
and J J Singleton have permission to
enclose temporarily the Allys exten-
ding through Blocks 77 and 78 in the
City of Lufkin adjourned until
the Regular Meeting in Oct
