

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD AUGUST 7th, 1934.

Be it remembered that on this the 7th day of August, A.D. 1934,
there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission in
and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City,
with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-
C. A. Burke, Mayor, W. O. Greene, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, Louis
Hicks, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No.
4, R. C. Musslewhite, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary and
Acting City Manager. D. A. Campbell, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 was
absent on account of being out of City. The following proceedings
were had, to-wit:-

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Minutes of meetings held during the month of July, were read and
on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

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The question of providing an outlet from property of S.L. Randolph
to highway No. 94 over property belonging to H.J. Rye and wife, it was
unanimously carried that such an outlet be provided for and that same
be 30 feet in width. (Later:- A deed was made from H.J. Rye and wife to
City of Lufkin for a strip of land 30 feet in width off of the East end
of their property, for a price of \$25.00, which was paid.)

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Accounts and bills due by the City to various parties, firms and
corporations were presented for payment and it appearing that such of
said bills as had been properly approved for payment by the City Mgr.
should be paid, on motion duly made and carried they were allowed.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on
motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
