CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION HELD SEPTEMBER 29th, 1934.

Be it remembered that on this the 29th day of September, A.D. 1934,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission in and
for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City,
with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

C. A. Burke,	Mayor,
W. O. Greene,	Coms. Ward No. 1,
Louis Hicks,	Coms. Ward No. 2,
D. A. Campbell,	Coms. Ward No. 3.
W. A. Abney,	Coms. Ward No. 4,
Curtis W. Fenley,	City Attorney, and
T. L. Dunn,	City Secretary, and
	Acting City Manager.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Lieutenant Manley, representing the C.C.Camp appeared before
the City Commission and stated the Government desired a location on
which to build an office building. It appearing to the City Commission
already was the owner of Lot No. 8 in Block No. 1 of the West End Ad-
dition, but that it was not large enough for the building designed.
It also appeared that Lot No. 9, adjoining said Lot No. 8 could be
purchased for a sum of \$400.00, which would provide a site large e-
nough to accomodate the building desired. The City Commission agreed
to purchase the said lot and lease both Lots Nos 8 and 9 of Block No.
1 of the West End Addition to the Government for the purpose desired
at a lease rental of \$66.00 per annum. Closing of the deal for the
lot was deferred until a lease contract could be agreed upon between
the City and Government.

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It was made known to the City Commission that a Tax Judgment
existed against D.H.Adams covering Lots Nos. 1 and 2 of Block No. 3
of the Adams Addition to the City of Lufkin, Texas, and that said
property was now owned by Holly Claybon, (Col), and that the said
Holly Claybon desired to pay all City Taxes due against said prop-
erty by securing a Home Owner's Loan Corporation Loan, and that it
was necessary that a Release of said Tax Judgment would have to be
executed inso far as Lots Nos 1 and 2 of Block No. 3 of said Adams
Addition was concerned before the loan could be granted. It was there-
for moved by W.O.Greene, and seconded By D.A.Campbell that the Mayor
be authorized to execute such release. The motion carried unanimous-
ly.

City Tax Collector T. L. Dunn reported that the City Tax Rolls for the year 1934 had been completed and said rolls were presented for examination and approval. They were examined. W. O. Greene made a motion that said tax rolls be approved and D.A. Campbell seconded the motion. It carried unanimously.

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G. W. Powell was duly appointed to the position of City Policeman to fill the vacancy caused by the death of C.W. Swan. See another page of these minutes for a complete record of the appointment of the said G. W. Powell.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, by motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
