Be It remembered that on this the 27th day of November, A.D. 1934,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission in and
for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City,
with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

D. A. Campbell, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 was absent on account
of being out of the City.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the meeting was to consider the passing of a res-
olution authorizing the collecting of delinquent City Advalorem Taxes
without adding any penalties, interest or costs.

W. O. Greene, Commissioner of Ward No. 1 introduced the follow-
ing resolution, which resolution was unanimously passed, it having
been moved by W. A. Abney and seconded by Louis Hicks that it do
pass, which did by the following vote, to-wit: "Ayes"- C.A.Burke,
W.O.Greene, Louis Hicks and W.A.Abney. "Noes"- None.

RESOLUTION.

Whereas, the Fourth Called Session of the 43rd Legislature being
House Bill No. 7, passed a law releasing all delinquent taxes that may
have become delinquent before August 1st, 1934, from penalty and in-
terest, and

Whereas, the said law does not become effective until February
9th, 1935, and

Whereas, the payment of delinquent taxes by the taxpayers of the
City of Lufkin, has almost ceased, and

Whereas, the City of Lufkin ~~has~~ needs the funds that it derives
from the payment of delinquent taxes, in order to meet its obliga-
tions, and

Whereas, the City of Lufkin has several thousands of dollars in
delinquent taxes now due the said City,

Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the
City of Lufkin that the City Tax Assessor and Collector by hereby

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directed to accept the amount of taxes without penalty and interest assessed against any property that may have become delinquent before August 1st, 1934, and issue the usual delinquent tax receipt therefor.

Be It Further Resolved that the City Tax Assessor and Collector be hereby directed to issue the usual tax certificate showing delinquent taxes paid in full for any year, paid in accordance with this Resolution.

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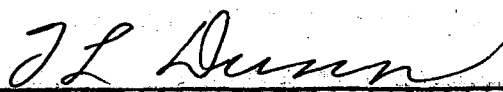
There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
