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MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD JULY 18, 1935.

Be it remembered that on this the 18th day of July, A.D. 1935, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, in and for said City at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was pass a resolution pertaining to the paving or re-paving of Raguet Street from Abney Avenue to Ellis Avenue to the effect that requisition be made to the State Highway Department authorizing them to make requisition to the Federal Bureau of Road for sufficient funds to do said work out of the 1935 allotment to the Federal Government for Street Work inside City limits. Also to pass a resolution requesting the State Highway Department to make application for an appropriation from the State Highway Department for the paving of Ellis Avenue on Highway No 94 from Kelly Street to ~~Ellis Avenue~~ ^{Raguet St} Raguet St.

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A resolution pertaining to the re-paving of Ellis Avenue, which is Highway No 40 (State) and Federal Highway No 69, was introduced for passage and approval. Same Having been read to the City Commission, it was moved By W.O. Greene and seconded by D.A. Campbell, that said resolution be passed and approved. The following is the recorded vote on the motion: "Ayes"- Kenneth Hoskins, W.O. Greene, Louis Hicks, D.A. Campbell, and W.A. Abney. "Noes"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution passed and approved. (See another page for the resolution)

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^{Raguet St} A resolution pertaining to the paving of Ellis Ave from Kelly St to Raguet St, which is also a part of Highway No 94, was also presented for passage and approval. It was read to the City Commission and W.A. Abney moved and Louis Hicks seconded that it be passed and approved. It carried unanimously.

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The bid of the First State bank for City Depository was unanimously rejected and it was ordered that new bids be asked for.

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No further business, on motion made and carried the meeting adjourned.
