

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING HELD
August 23rd, A.D. 1935.

Be it remembered that on this the 23rd day of August A.D. 1935, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers present and presiding:

Mayor Kenneth Hoskins and City Attorney Curtis W. Fenley were absent.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the meeting was to discuss again with Mr. Olson the matter of drilling test holes for a water supply, it appearing that a former contract had to be rewritten and passed on again.

An Ordinance providing for the drilling of test hole or holes to determine whether or not it is feasible to develop a well water supply for the City of Lufkin for service to said city and vicinity and authorizing a contract with Lave-Texas Company therefor, was presented to the City Commission for passage and approval. It was moved by W. A. Abney and seconded by D.A. Campbell that the ordinance be read and that it be finally passed and approved. Carried.

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Some other things relating to the city's business was discussed but nothing further of record was transacted.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
