

Lynn Jan Feb 5th 1898.

At the call session of the City Council Mayor J. C. Maitland in the Chair, Aldermen W. H. Brown & D. M. Brown, H. Haygood & J. Kerr, Marshals W. W. & M. Conroy, J. C. & J. W. Johnson the meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted.

It was moved & seconded that the Council accept the report of the Waterworks Committee for the location of the Standpipes which is on Block 37 in the City of Lynn and owned by A. C. Vinson. Mr. Vinson being present before the Council and offered for sale Lot 4 and one half of Lot 5 in Block 37, and being 150 feet fronting on ^{the north side} Paul Street and running north to 140 feet to a 20 foot alley being 140 feet fronting on the west side of Third Street for a consideration of Two Hundred and fifty ^{\$250⁰⁰} it was moved and carried that the proposition of A. C. Vinson be accepted.
