A/c of J. P. Davis for Rent of office allowed 6⁰⁰. A/c of H. S. Kerr W. Albry. M. C. Weaver J. M. Seurlock A. C. Jones. 2⁰⁰ Each for holding Election was allowed and warrants issued for same. A. W. Ellis allowed \$25⁰⁰ per day for use of his team and driver on street work. A. R. Moons resignation for as treasurer was presented and received. J. M. Seurlock Elected Treasurer.
