

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD March 15
1955, AT 7:30 P.M.

On this the 15 day of March, A. D. 1955,
the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened
in regular session, in the regular meeting place in
said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: L. C. Britain
 , constituting a quorum when the follow-
ing business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.
2. The minutes of the regular meeting held on March 1, 1955, were read and approved.
3. Mr. E. A. Stanfield appeared before the City Commission and discussed the traffic congestion and the parking in the vicinity of the Lufkin Foundry & Machine Company. After discussing the situation, it was agreed that the City Manager would meet with the officials of the Foundry to see if something could not be worked out to relieve the traffic congestion in the area.
4. Mr. Buddy McKinney appeared before the Commission in the interest of the proposed ordinance regulating the size of placards or signs to be displayed by filing station operators. The matter was deferred until the City could obtain information relative to such ordinances from the League of Texas Municipalities.
5. The County Judge and County Attorney came before the City Commission and discussed driving while intoxicated cases. After discussing the matter, all agreed to cooperate in the enforcement of the law in every way.
6. The Unity Baptist Association was refunded the sum of \$28.00 for taxes for the year 1953, these having been paid on property used for church purposes.

7. The Budget, as previously advertised, for the fiscal year 1955-1956, was adopted.

8. Bills for the month of February were approved and ordered paid.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
