1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.

2. The Minutes of the Regular Meeting of January 4, were read and approved.

3. A petition by residents on Tom Temple Boulevard requesting the City to pick up garbage was presented to the Commission. After discussing the petition, it was agreed to postpone further action on such application until the next regular meeting of the Commission. It was agreed that someone representing the City would go over the proposed route and inspect same and then the Commission would determine the advisability of taking on such route.

- 4 Mr. Robert Denum appeared before the Commission and wanted to purchase a part of the Booker T. Robinson lot, purchased for a right-of-way by the City of Lufkin, and also a portion of Lot Number 3 of the Berry property. After discussing such request of purchase, it was agreed that the City would convey to Robert Denum such portions of said lots for the sum of \$865, and that the said Robert Denum would pay for the surveying of such portions.

5. The City Manager presented to the City Commission a recommendation for appointment of a Chief of Police, such application did not meet with the unanimous approval of the City Commission because he was not a resident of Lufkin and Angelina County. After discussing same, the recommendation was withdrawn by the City Manager.

6. Plat of Charlie Norris Addition was presented to the Commission and such plat was approved.

7. Bills for the month of December were approved and ordered paid.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
