

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE  
CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON MARCH 28, 1961, at 7:30 PM

2. Mayor Jim Waters stated this meeting was called for the purpose of opening bids on Contract No. 4, West Side Trunk Sewer Line and Lift Station and welcomed a number of visitors who were present in connection with the bids.
