Mr. J. W. Marshall was present in the interest of renewal  
lease on the Air Port but refused to sign the lease as pre-  
pared and presented to him.

After considerable discussion of the  
matter a resolution was offered by R. E. Melvin, seconded by  
B. F. Milligan and carried by all members voting yea. authorizing  
the City Manager to execute a lease contract for Six Months  
to Mr. Marshall on the Air Port, with the privilege of cancellation  
by either party on Ten days notice and giving him thirty days  
time in which to remove his improvements in the event of can-  
cellation or expiration, also giving Mr. Marshall the privilege  
of accepting the lease contract offered to him on February 10th
