Mr. J. W. Marshall was present in the interest of renewal lease on the Air Fort but refused to sign the lease as prepared and presented to him.

After considerable discussion of the matter a resolution was offered by R. E. Melvin, seconded by B. F. Milligan and carried by all members voting yea.authorizing the City Manager to execute a lease contract for Six Months to Mr. Marshall on the Ait Port, with the privilege of cancellation by either party on Ten days notice and giving him thirty days time in which to remove his improvements in the event of cancellation or expiration, also giving Mr. Marshall the privilege of accepting the lease contract offered to him on February 10th at any time within six months from this date.

There was nothing further presented for attention and the meeting recessed to February 18th at 2:30 PM.
