

Lufkin, Texas, October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1893.

The Town Council of the Town of Lufkin, Texas, met this day in regular session. Present,

Mayor B. L. McPherson in the chair, and Aldermen Medford, Vinson and Abney.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Claim of Clarke & Co., stationers, Galveston Texas, for \$12.50 for supplies and stationery, audited and allowed (See Audited Claim No. 44)

At request, Mr. V. V. Daniels, Editor Lufkin Leader appeared before the Council and explained his construction of printing contracts made with the Town Apr. 21, 1893. Stated that he did not understand that he was to print stationery, legal blanks, etc. - Would print such, however, at certain definite rates.

The Town Secretary was directed to procure of V. V. Daniels 250 Complaints and 250 warrants of Arrest at a cost not to exceed \$300 for aggregate -

Claim of W. H. Lisbony for \$2.50 for Town Seal audited and allowed, and Town Treasurer directed to pay cash for same to F. B. Forster, Town Secretary, who will transmit same to W. H. Lisbony. (See audited Claim No. 45). Seal approved and accepted -

Claim of A. M. Ellis for salary as Marshal for September, 1893, <sup>and expenditures</sup> and monthly and quarterly report for month and quarter ending Sept. 30 1893, audited, and approved and allowed. (See audited Claim No. 43)

Claim of F. B. Forster for Atty's fees and balance on salary as Secretary for Aug. & Sept. 1893, Audited and allowed, and Claim
