Council Met in Regular Session
 Quorum Present the following Business
 Was ~~attended~~ Transacted

- 1 Be it ordained by the Council of the
 Town of Luffkin that the Attorney for the
 Corporation shall be allowed the sum of
 five Dollars in every case in which he
 Represents the Corporation and secures
 a Conviction, but when there is no
 Conviction the Attorney gets nothing; and
 further, in all cases when a Defendant
 is Prosecuted and comes before the court
 and enters a plea of Guilt, the court
 shall assess a trial fee of five Dollars
 Defendant Which shall be collected by the Marshall
 and Paid over to the town treasurer as
 other fines and forfeitures
- 2 that W.D. Roberts be allowed twenty five
 Cents for Hauling off a Dead Dog to be
 Credited on his Proportional occupation Tax
- 3 the Mayor may appoint an attorney or
 Attornies to represent the Corporation
 whenever necessary.
