City Council of City of Lufkin, Tex. met in call session with the following present and acting: A. M. Denman, Mayor; E. N. Humason, Secretary.

The following members of council were absent and fined \$3.00 for non-attendance: R. B. Shearer, S. H. Townsend, W. D. Price, J. A. Johnson, T. W. Largent, alderman.

This meeting was called for the purpose of auditing City Treasurer Bonner's report. After careful examination of report by those present, there shows to be \$2,284.90 in general fund, and since report was made \$324.35 more has been paid into said fund, making a total in general fund to date \$2,609.25.

Water Works fund shows by report to have \$1,035.15 on hand, but we find that there should be \$53.82 more added to same.

Corporation court fund shows \$154.10 on hand.

Street and alley fund \$12.78 due treasurer.

It was ordered by Mayor that the fines which were assessed against aldermen when collected, are to be divided equally between himself and secretary.

No further business, council adjourned until Tuesday night at 7-30 P.M. Dec. 17th 1903.
