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1. The purpose of the meeting was to read and approve bills due various parties and concerns and to take up anyother matter that might come before the Council.

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2. A Motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by G. W. Roland that bills be allowed and paid for the Months of November and December. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "NOES" None.

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3. A Motion was made by G. W. Roland and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that Traffic Signal Light be installed at South First and Burke Avenue. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE" "NOES" NONE.

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4. Minutes for previous meeting were read an approved as read. All voted "AYE". "NOES" NONE.

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5. The City's Water Rates were discussed and upon motion duly made by C. C. Sinclair and seconded by G. W. Roland, that City go back to the rate charged prior to June 29th, 1949. Mayor put motion to a vote. C. C. Sinclair, "AYE", G. W. Roland "AYE", Granville Wright, "AYE". L. C. Martin (not Voting). Rates to be effective Feb. 1st, 1949 Billing. (\$2.00 Minimum for 5,000 Gallons-Residential, ~~\$15.00~~ 1.50, 3,000 Gal. Commercial.

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6. There being no further business to come before the meeting, and on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
