Council Met in Call Session
 of Mantooth Mayor in the Chair

 Bonner W M Jones Adamen Present
 and the following business was
 Transacted (to wit)

Be it ordained by the City Council
 of the City of Lufkin that E. C.
 Shirey be and he is hereby
 appointed City Marshall of
 the City of Lufkin, to fill the
 unexpired term of J. B. McConico
 who resigned, upon his giving
 Bond in the sum of five Hundred
 Dollars as ^{such} City Marshal, and five Hundred
 Dollars as City Assessor ^{and collector} and otherwise
 qualifying according to Law and
 the ordinances of said City
 it is further ordered that the said
 E. C. Shirey shall be allowed the
 sum of Thirty five Dollars per
 month for his services as City
 Marshall. Payable out of the General
 fund of the City Corporation
 and the sum of 2 1/2 per cent
 for assessing and 2 1/2 per cent
 for collecting the Taxes of said
 City and the further compensation
 as are allowed Constables for like
 Criminal services performed in
 the execution of all Criminal
 process issuing out of said Mayor's
 Court of said City of Mantooth
