

MINUTES OF CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN HELD
AUGUST 20, 1929.

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 20th day of August, A. D. 1929, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Hall thereof with the following members and officers present, to-wit: Joe C. Denman, Mayor; C. A. Burke Commissioner Ward No.2; R. C. Jordan Commissioner Ward No.3; and W. A. Abney Commissioner Ward No.4; W. D. Tiner City Manager; T. L. Dunn, City Secretary; J. B. Woiton, City Engineer; and W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when among other matters the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

It appearing to the City Commission that the following portions of streets and avenues, viz:

(1) Jodie Avenue from its intersection with the west line of South Second Street to its intersection with the east line of South First Street.

(2) Burke Avenue from its intersection with the east line of South Angeline Street to its intersection with west line of South First Street.

(3) Paul Avenue from its intersection with the east line of Third Street to its intersection with the west line of Sixth Street.

(4) Polk Avenue from its intersection with east line of North First Street to its intersection with west line of North Third Street.

(5) Rhodes Avenue from its intersection with east line of North Second Street to its intersection with west line of North Third Street.

(6) South Second Street from its intersection with S. E. corner of Lot 6, Block 4 of the Jordan-Davis Addition to its intersection with the most northerly corner of block 14 of the Denman Addition,

have been completed according to contract for street paving with Scott Shambaugh of Houston, Texas, of date April 2nd, 1929, and the acceptance of said streets and avenues has been recommended in writing by the City Engineer; on motion C. A. Burke, seconded by W. A. Abney, all voting "yea", said streets and avenues were accepted from Scott Shambaugh, paving contractor, and said improvement on said streets and avenues are now received and accepted by the City of Lufkin.

The Mayor and City Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to issue improvement assessment certificates therefor in accordance with the assessment ordinance heretofore, passed, a form of said assessment certificate has heretofore been approved *for* use in the present

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paving program, which is in all respects approved.
