(1) South First Street from its intersection with South line of Pershing Avenue to City Limits;

has been completed according to contract for street paving with Scott Shambaugh of Houston, Texas, of date April 2nd, 1929 A. D., and the acceptance of said street has been recommended in writing by the City Engineer, Mr. J. B. Welton; on motion of W. A. Abney, seconded by G. A. Burke, all voting "yea", said street was accepted from Scott Shambaugh, paving contractor, and said improvements on said street are now received and accepted by the City of Lufkin.

The Mayor and City Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to issue improvement assessment certificates therefor in accordance with the assessments ordinance heretofore passed.

when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

THE PURPOSE of this meeting as stated by the Mayor was to discuss the advisability of passing an ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor and Secretary to make, execute and deliver to the adjacent property owners that abandoned portion of Jay Street north of Abney Avenue in the City of Lufkin, which is approximately 150 feet west from where Sayers Street now intersects Abney Avenue, the said Jay Street or road being the same passageway that ran between the M. K. Sayers homestead property and the W. A. Abney Sr. Homestead property, the conveyance to cover all the right, title and interest of the City in and to said abandoned portion of said Jay Street, 1/2 thereof to each of the property owners on the west, and 1/2 thereof to each of the property owners on the east, and such other business as might properly come before the meeting.

On motion of Commissioner C. A. Burke, seconded by Commissioner Jordan, all present voting "Yes", the Mayor, Hon. Joe C. Dorman, and the City Secretary, T. L. Dunn, be and they are hereby authorized and directed in the name of the City of Lufkin, Texas, to make, execute and deliver to the respective property owners owning property adjacent to the abandoned portion of Jay Street in the City of Lufkin, Texas all the right, title and interest of the City of Lufkin in and to said abandoned portion of Jay Street, 1/2 thereof to each of the property owners adjacent thereto on the west side thereof, and 1/2 thereof to each of the property owners adjacent thereto on the east side thereof, for and in consideration of one dollar and other valid and valuable considerations.

- Be it remembered that on this the 24th day of Sept. A.D. 1929, there was held a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said said City, with the following officers of the City present, to-wit:- Joe C. Denman, Mayor, S. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. A. Abney Commissioner of Ward No. 4, W. D. Tiner, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss means of getting something done towards paving Sayers Street, and any such other business as might properly come before the meeting.

It appearing that there was an old abandoned street, known as Jay street running north from Abney Avenue about on a division line between the Sayers and Abney properties, and that owners of property on eaither side of said abandoned street were desirous of the City Making each of them a deed to one half of said street adjacent to their respective properties. It was therefore moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by R. C. Jordan that the Mayor be authorized to execute quitclaim deeds to each property owner along said abandoned street for one-half of the wide thereof. The motion haveing been put by the mayor said motion carried unanimously.

It appearing that South First Street had been paved according to contract and that acceptance of same had been recommended in writing by the City Engineer, it was moved by W.A. Abney and seconded by C.A. Burke that same be accepted. The motion carried unanimously.

On motion by W A Abney seconded by C A Burke, it having been first recommended by the City Engineer, the street intersection at S. Third, Kerr and Denman Avenue was accepted by a unanimous vote of the City Commission as paved in accordance with contract.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.
