

Lufkin Texas June 25th 1898

The Council met in extra session May or J.C. Mautook in the Chair with aldermen Glenn, J.A. Haygood & H.D. Heaven ~~present~~. Marshall W. McConico attorney E.B. Rott and Geo. Geo. Johnson present.

The meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted.

Moved and Carried that a 12x80 foot Stand Pipe be ^{adopted and} erected and at a place hereinafter designated by the Committee which was appointed and composed of J.C. Mautook H.D. Heaven & Geo. Johnson

Moved and Carried that a 12 inch main be adopted.

Moved and Carried that any and all Water Closets, Privies or any other structures by whatsoever name that is located on or that is indirectly located on any of the streets and main "oroughs" of the City of Lufkin shall be and is hereby condemned by the City Council and the City Marshal is hereby ordered to have them removed or destroyed.

"Ordinance"

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Lufkin that it shall be unlawful Art 176 for any person to drive any wagon or other vehicle into or across any ditch in this City except at a regular crossing and any person violating the provisions of this article shall be fined in any sum not to exceed five dollars.
