Visitors to the meeting were Mr. H. J. Shands and Mr. C. E. Cortes.

Mr. Early made a statement of the Citys' financial condition as of December, 12, 1946. A lengthy discussion of financial matters was held but no official action was taken.

1. The matter of paying City employees a Christmas bonus was brought up by Mayor Winston and after a brief discussion it was moved by E. A. Gibbs and seconded by D. M. Thrash to pay a bonus equivalent to 25% of one months wages to all City employees who had been working for the City six months prior to December 1, 1946 and who were still employed by the City. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.
