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MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY

Be it remembered that on this the 28th day of July, A.D. 1930 there was held a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal office there of in said city. with the following officers of the City present, to-wit:- ~~C.A. Burke, Mayor Protem~~presiding, (~~Mayor Joe E. Denman~~ being absent) C.E. Brazil, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, C.A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W.A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, W.D. Tiner, City Manager and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The Mayor ~~pret~~em announced that the purpose of the meeting was to pass on second reading the following ordinances: (1) An Ordinance appointing the members of the Board of Equalization of the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year 1930, and (2) An ordinance making the annual tax levy of the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year 1930, and to do and perform any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

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An ordinance entitled "An Ordinance appointing the Members of the Board of Equalization in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year A.D. 1930" was presented for passage and approval on second reading. C.A. Burke made a motion which was seconded by W.A. Abney, that said ordinance be placed on second reading and that same pass second reading. The motion was put by the Mayor ^{Protem} and the following vote is here recorded: "AYES" ~~C.A. Burke, C.E. Brazil, R.C. Jordan and W.A. Abney.~~ "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the ordinance passed on second reading.

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An ordinance entitled "An Ordinance prescribing the Taxes to be levied, assessed and collected by the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year 1930, and for each year thereafter until otherwise provided" was presented for passage and approval on second reading. R.C. Jordan made a motion which was seconded by C.E. Brazil that said ordinance be placed on second reading and that same pass second reading. The Mayor ~~protem~~ put the question and following vote is here recorded: "AYES" C.A. Burke, C.E. Brazil, R.C. Jordan and W.A. Abney. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor ~~protem~~ declared the ordinance passed on second reading.
