The matter of providing Right-of-way through the City for new location for Highway 59 was discussed and also the proposed plan for construction of the highway, after which a resolution was introduced by R. E. Melvin, second by B. F. Milligan and carried by all members voting yea, obligating the City to provide right-of-way Ninety four feet wide from the North City limits as far as the construction includes, curb and gutter and sidewalks and One Hundred ten feet wide for the remainder of the distance to the South City Limits.
