HELD MARCH 27th, A. D. 1936.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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This meeting was called for the purpose of discussing the Airport
Project filed with the WPA, it appearing that the WPA at San Antonio,
State Headquarters, would not approve same because sufficient time does
not exist to complete same before June 30th, 1936, the official date
that all WPA projects must cease unless the Government sees fit to ex-
tend the time beybind that date.

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The matter was thoroughly discussed after which it was decided
that Mayor Kenneth Hoskins and Ed C. Burris, Secretary of the Chamber
of Commerce should go to San Antonio to confer with WPA officials with
the idea in view to get approval of the project regardless of the dead
line date, and to agree that if extension of time is not given that we
would take what we could get done by such date.
