Be it remembered that on this the 16th day of Sept A. D. 1912 there came on and was held a SPECIAL CALL Meeting of the Honorable City Council of the City of Lufkin, in the Council Chamber of said city, there being present and presiding the following officers:

The purpose of the meeting as explained by the Mayor being to discuss the water works situation.

Alderman Callmorgen reported a way whereby the City could arrange for funds with which to finance the new water works proposition - the terms of which being virtually to turn the management of said water works over to the party or parties loaning said money to the City. The above terms being objectionable to the Council.

Alderman Price made a motion seconded by Alderman Campbell, that the above terms be rejected. He stood on this as follows: Campbell, Price & Roach voted aye - Callmorgen ~~not~~ voting aye.

Motion by Cummings seconded by Price and motion carried that this city proceed with its improvements connecting the new waterworks with the old, paying for said improvements ~~out of the~~ with Townarrants on the General or any available fund.

Motion carried that the city purchase from G. R. Johnson one four (4") Relief valve and complete relief system for the new water works station.

Water Cannon Gray instructed to procure laborers and proceed at once to cut and seal right of way for new water line from new station to old - Mr. N. D. Hauss city engineer agreeing to lay out the line with an instrument -
