 purpose of dissolving the Water Contract.

And it appearing to the Council that  
 the firm of Lague & Bowers with which the City  
 had entered into a contract by which  
 the said Lague & Bowers agreed to furnish  
 the City of Lepuskin Artesian Water Well or Wells  
 of 300,000 gallons capacity per day of  
 24 hours have been <sup>and</sup> are negligent  
 in the carrying out of the contract with  
 the City of Lepuskin, On Motion of Alderman  
 W. A. Calverley Second by W. D. Price  
 and Carried unanimously the City Secretary  
 was instructed to notify the said firm  
 of Lague & Bowers that the City of Lepuskin  
 does no longer feel itself bound  
 by that contract - which by the very  
 acts of the said firm of Lague & Bowers  
 has become & is now null & void -

On Motion of Largent Sec by Bunde That  
 the City Engineer make the necessary surveys of  
 the City Reservoir with the view of raising the City  
 dam from 3 to 4 feet. Carried.
