#### AN ORDINANCE.

Be it ordained by the city council of the City of Lufkin that all buildings within 125 feet of the main sewer pipe or lateral containing or hereafter to contain a water closet, urinal, sink, basin, wash-tray, bath and every tub or set of tubs and hydrant waste pipe must be connected with the main sewer pipe. Water closets when placed within 125 feet and not within any buildings shall be connected with the main sewer pipe. All connections shall be examined by the Plumbing Inspector, and must be approved by him.

Be it further ordained that all water closets, urinals, sinks, wash trays, bath tubs, hydrants and waste pipes now in use and which have been erected and used previous to the passage of this ordinance shall be connected with the main sewer pipe within sixty days after the passage of this ordinance.

Be it further ordained that the installation of all water closets, bath tubs, etc., as enumerated above and the material and workmanship used in their construction shall be subject to the rules governing plumbing as may be prescribed.

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon

conviction before any court of competent jurisdiction, shall be fined not less than ten nor more than twenty-five dollars.

Be it furthermore ordained that all other rules and regulations upon the subjects embodied in this ordinance and in conflict with same are hereby repealed.
