

Lufkin Tex April 12. 1895

In pursuance to an order passed at the regular meeting of Town Council on the 8th day of April 1895 the Council met, present: E. J. Maitovich Mayor S. Abram J. Kern W. M. Jones R. B. Sherrin and W. H. Bower alder men present.

Be it ordained by the town Council of the town of Lufkin that the Mossell shall receive an annual salary of four hundred and twenty dollars and the fees of office in Criminal and Civil cases such fees as are allowed Constables for like service and a commission of five per cent on all taxes collected from the town by him and in case where property is levied and sold for taxes he shall receive the same compensation as is allowed by the state to sheriffs and constables for making a levy or sale in similar cases but in no case to include commission on such sales.
