

MINUTES OF CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS?
HELD January 14th, 1930.

Be it remembered that on this the 14th day of January, A.D. 1930,
there was held a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of
Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City with the
following officers of the City present:- Joe. C. Denman, Mayor, C. A.
Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward
3, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, W. D. Tiner, City Mana-
ger, W. O. Seale, City Attorney, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary,
(C.E. Brazil, Commissioner of Ward No. 1 being absent) when the fol-
lowing proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to dis-
cuss with Mr. Camp, representing the Sanitary Appliances Co of Houston,
Texas, the question of installing what is known as "Pit Type Toilets"
in the City at places where connections could not be had from the
Sanitary Sewer lines.


Mr. Camp went into details at considerable length, explain-
ing the method of operation of the Pit Type Toilets, the cost of in-
stallation and the length of life of same, and the manner of pay-
ing for same. Many questions were asked relative same; what suc-
cess other cities were having with such toilets etc. which were all
answered by Mr. Camp. After discussing the question, it was unani-
mously decided to defer any action regarding the executing of a con-
tract for the installation of such toilets until the next regular
meeting of the City Commission in February.
