being present, constituting a quorum, when the following business was transacted:

- After an informal discussion of proposed formula for sanitary sewer charges to industries discharging waste into City of Lufkin sewer system, Mayor called a special meeting of City Commission.
- 2. CL made motion that City Commission waive any necessity of notice of special meeting. ECW seconded the motion and a unanimous affirmative vote was recorded.
- 3. BEA made motion that authorization be given to publishing proposed Ordinance fixing and establishing sanitary sewer service rates for those persons, firms or corporations discharging industrial waste into the sanitary sewer system of the City of Lufkin, providing penalties for violation thereof and providing an effective date, for first reading in meeting of March 17, 1970, and amending present Ordinance with regard to rates to be determined by contract. WOR seconded the motion and a unanimous affirmative vote was recorded.
- 4. There being no further business for consideration, meeting was adjourned at 1:15 P.M.
