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The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

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1. The purpose of the meeting was to pass resolution canvassing
returns of the Special Election on second reading, and to discuss
any other business that might come before the meeting. (See another

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2. A Motion was made by G. Etra Barington, and seconded by J. E.
Jay, authorizing Mayor W. M. Glenn, to execute Contract with T. P.
& Light Company for 5 years including the Lufkin Indp. School Dist.
same being a savings in Power Cost to the School Dist., The Mayor
put the question to a vote. All voted "Aye". Noes, None.

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3. A Motion was made by G. Etra Barington, and seconded by W. D.
Winston, Jr., authorizing the Mayor to execute contract (Rent Agreement)
between City of Lufkin, Texas, and the Texas Re-employment Service.
The Mayor put the question to a vote. All voted "Aye. Noes--None.

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4. It was agreed to let Mr. J. O. Booker do the field work on the
WPA Paving job; starting Booker and a crew of men Monday A.M.

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5. There being no further business to come before the meeting, on
motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
