 that it be accepted  
 by City Council  
 Motion carried

 that the Mayor and

 contract in behalf  
 of the City of Lufkin  
 up according to the  
 plans, specifications  
 and terms of in  
 and accompanying  
 the bid.

 by Alderman Price  
 that W. E. Coffey  
 be allowed \$64.00  
 Sixth day for six weeks  
 help labor at city  
 pump station, and  
 that whenever he  
 opposed favor him against  
 Dr. H. D. Special Fund

 \$75 for wages paid to  
 Rosh & Lewis for

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labor at city pump
